

Summer Reading Requirement- 2nd to 3rd grade

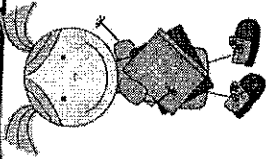

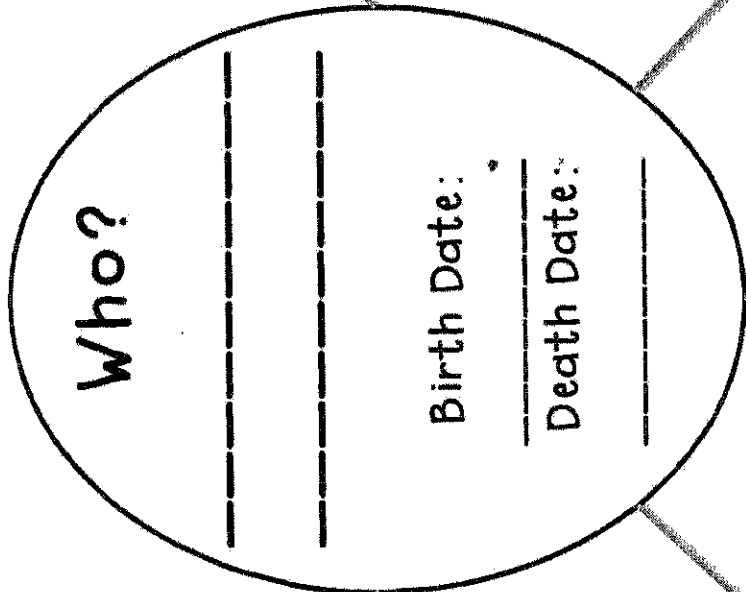
